You and your team will begin work on August 1, and will continue to work until you celebrate the night of the coronation ball.

You and your team should be prepared to incur expenses that could arise from the events and ball. CALB does provide a financial budget, however anything above or beyond that budget ultimately becomes the responsibility of the King and Queen candidate.

You will be responsible for forming your team, appointing a team captain and for filling in the gaps that the team is unable to cover. You will need to appoint a liaison between the team and the CALB board.

The following Carnival season, the reigning King and Queen will be expected to represent CALB as "visiting royalty" at various balls along the coast. *(If you are unable to attend it will be your responsibility to appoint someone)*

As reigning royalty both King and Queen must remain active throughout their term at all functions. Both positions will be voting CALB Board members and will be presented at the CALB Ball. Reigning royalty will ride in the CALB parade the following season.

As a royal candidate and a reigning King and Queen, you become an official representative of the Carnival Association of Long Beach and in turn, St. Thomas the Apostle Catholic Church and St. Vincent DePaul Catholic School.
