Requirements

1. You must be a senior in high school and attend one of the following: Long Beach High School, Pass Christian High School, Our Lady Academy, St. Patrick's or St. Stanislaus. Applicants who do not attend the above mentioned schools but whose



parents/guardians are active, paid members of CALB may also apply for scholarship consideration.

2. You or a family member must have an affiliation with Carnival Association of Long Beach. This can be as a volunteer, board member, team member, court member or past royalty of CALB. Please list names, positions and years affiliated (if known).

- 3. The application must be typed.
- 4. An unofficial copy of your transcript must be included.
- 5. A complete resume listing all extracurricular activities, club memberships with any offices held, civic involvement, community involvement, church activities, interests, hobbies and work experience. This is for the grades of 9-12 only.
- 6. At least 2 letters of recommendation. Ideally, one letter from a teacher/school administrator and one from civic/community/church leader.
- 7. Answer the application questions using detailed answers.
